Construction managers make one of the **highest salaries** in the construction industry, at an average of \$93,370/year. This is because of the knowledge and skill required to do this job effectively.

The construction manager is the person **in charge** of any construction project, residential or commercial. They are involved in the planning, construction, and completion of the building. They accomplish all this by knowing about every part of construction including plumbing, carpentry, electricity, and masonry.
